Update on Promotion of All-Class Luncheon – Jackie King

The Spring Membership/Luncheon postcard mailer is in production and will be mailed as soon as Seattle Mailing Bureau (SMB) receives our postage check. The total postcards to be mailed (TMP, FMR) is 7,419. The cost is \$887.41 for printing and \$974.40 for postage for a total of \$1,861.41. This puts us over the original budget of \$1,500 by \$361.41.

By paring down the number of out-of-state alumni and eliminating unknown, deceased, and bad addresses, we are able to mail fewer postcards than originally anticipated. SMB provided us with a list of 250 alumni with changed addresses that Monica has been updating in the database. Linda researched extensively over 130 names/bad addresses to find good addresses for the mailing list and our database. Thanks for the hard work, ladies! Now, hopefully, we won't get too many returns!
