The History of Lincoln High School



Lincoln High School - 1907

Early in spring 1906, a group of Seattle School Board members crossed Lake Union and headed north to the small neighborhood of Wallingford in search of a site for a new high school in the north end of the city. Lincoln High School, during the 50s was the largest high school in the state. In the 80s the school closed due to declining enrollment. Because of changing community demographics, Lincoln will reopen in 2019 as a state-of-the-art, four-year high school.
